



CALLINGTON TOWN BAND

RULES

“The following rules should be read and signed as acceptance by each band member:

1. The secretary must issue a copy of the rules to each member and retain a signed copy.
2. The rules can only be changed at an Annual General Meeting or at an Extraordinary General Meeting.
3. Rule amendments will be published and must be read and signed for by band member.
4. All property belonging to Callington Town Band and loaned to members will remain the property of Callington Town Band and can be recalled at any time.
5. No property whatsoever belonging to Callington Town Band can be sold, or disposed of without the Consent of the majority of the Executive Committee.
6. All property of Callington Town Band and loaned to a band member must be signed for by that member.
7. Any damage or loss to any item loaned to a band member must be reported to a committee member immediately, with the objective of the committee deciding on who should bear the cost of the replacement or repair.
8. Membership of the Callington Town Band will be available on payment of an annual subscription fee. The subscription fee will be decided by the committee and voted upon at the AGM. Subscription fees to be paid to the Treasurer.
9. Instruments on loan from the band may only be used in other bands or concerts with prior consent from the Chairman, Musical Director or Bandmaster.
(Failure do so may invalidate any insurance claim).
10. It is the responsibility of all playing members to attend rehearsals and concerts. Courtesy should ensure that all members advise the Bandmaster/MD in the event that they are unable to attend at least 5 days prior to an engagement.
11. Members of the Band should be aware of their behaviour both toward other members and, when in Public, ensure it is not of a nature to bring the name of the Band into disrepute.
12. Unless otherwise instructed all engagements will require full band uniform to be worn.
